- Easily fulfill regulatory reporting (e.g., U.S. DOT form 5800.1)
- Quickly notify clients of possible delays in shipments
- Identify training opportunities for your staff to support continuous improvement
- Online access to incident reports and charts that may be downloaded for future analysis and auditing

### Access and download incident reports and charts online for future analysis and auditing:

<b>Carrier Information Network</b>	When a carrier's contact information is on file with CHEMTREC, we can contact the carrier to research the identity of the product and/or the shipper. This helps us facilitate immediate, accurate responses in emergency situations.
<b>Incident Report Distribution</b>	The information provided in a CHEMTREC report can be used for more than simply notifying you of an incident involving your driver or vehicle. Analysis of the data retrieved by our trained Emergency Services Specialists will give you insight into how your own operations handle both large and small situations involving damaged or leaking freight, either over the road or in the terminal.
<b>Regulatory Reporting</b>	In addition to distributing relevant incident reports to your company, when you register for incident reporting, CHEMTREC will go a step further by reviewing your incidents to help determine if additional reporting may be needed based on Hazardous Materials Regulations (49 CFR Parts 171-180). If additional regulatory reporting to PHMSA is identified, CHEMTREC will work with you to complete and submit your U.S. DOT form 5800.1.
<b>Training</b>	CHEMTREC offers a variety of online training courses, including Ground Transportation 49 CFR Training for Carriers. This course will help provide your employees with the knowledge they need to fulfill the responsibilities as a ground transportation carrier using the U.S. DOT Code of Federal Regulations Title 49, otherwise known as 49 CFR.
